A Confident Start for Reception

Our new Reception class have made a confident start to school life. They have been busy exploring their classrooms, meeting new friends, and getting to know their teachers. Highlights of the week included a tour of the school and their very first assembly. Back in class, the children have enjoyed painting, storytelling, and role play, settling quickly into their routines and showing plenty of curiosity. Well done, Reception!



Year 2 Get Cooking

Year 2 have made a strong start to their Design Technology topic *Delicious Dishes*. In groups, the children sorted foods into categories and discussed whether they belonged to fruit, vegetables, grains or protein. They showed good teamwork and plenty of thought in their answers, setting themselves up well for the cooking work to come.



Year 3 Step Back in Time

Year 3 have made a great start to their history work by exploring how timelines help us understand the past. They worked together to spot the key features of a timeline and learned new terms including BC, AD, CE and BCE. Using their knowledge from Year 1 and 2, they sequenced events in order and placed them in relation to BC and AD. The children showed impressive recall, naming figures such as Florence Nightingale, Rosa Parks, Neil Armstrong and Emily Davison. They also found out where the Stone Age fits on a timeline, ready for their next topic.
