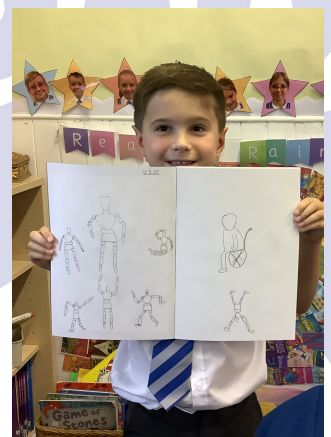
Year 1 Discover Where Their Food Comes From

Year 3 Explore Sketching the Human Form

Year 3 enjoyed a fabulous and relaxing afternoon of sketching with some truly impressive results. The children have been studying the human form and had lots of fun using a drawing mannequin to help them practise proportions. By starting with simple shapes and lines, they created figures that showed movement and character.

Next week, Year 3 will turn their attention to the work of LS Lowry and his famous matchstick figures, building on their skills to develop their own artistic style.
